Marriage: Minimum **Six months** noticed required. Couples must be practising members of our Parish. Call the Parish Office to arrange a meeting with the priest.

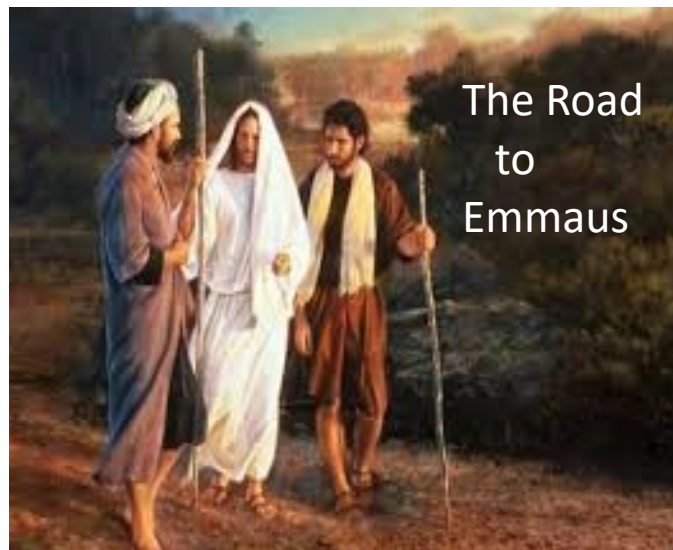

Reflections on the Sunday Readings: 3rd Sunday of Easter

We are tempted to forget about God in good times, but during hard times, such as illness or family crisis, our fears and insecurities can bring us back to God and his unconditional love. God gave his only Son so that we might have eternal life. We then can turn to God for help in our hour of need.

Today's Gospel recalls the appearance of Jesus to two disciples on the road to Emmaus. They were confused, perhaps frightened, and Jesus showed them the way. In the breaking of the bread he revealed himself as the risen Christ, and the disciples' hearts burned within. In our own life's journey, we are able to carry our crosses because Jesus walks with us. He is guiding and protecting—we need to learn to look with our hearts and eyes to recognize his presence.

What can we do to express gratitude for the great gift of Easter? By feeding our spirit, by receiving Jesus in communion, we ensure we are never separated from the joy experienced by the two disciples nor from the light that Jesus shines in our lives to show the way. Staying connected through prayer, we are grateful and gain consolation in difficult times. Jesus will carry us when we fall.

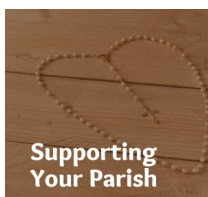

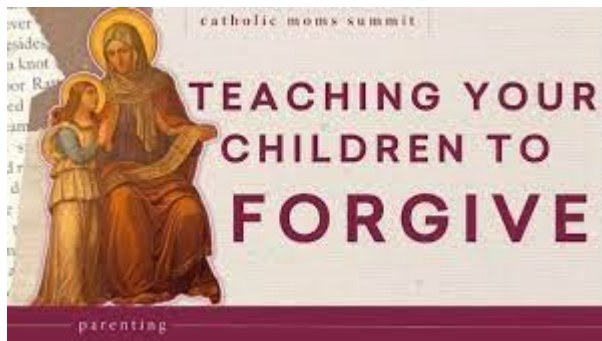

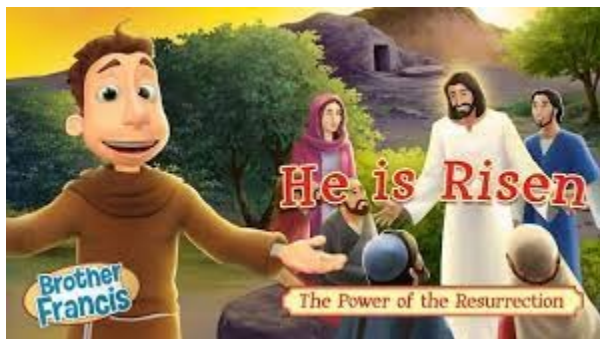

An animated presentation of key points in the life of Jesus Christ, His Death on the Cross, triumph over death, and Ascension to the Father

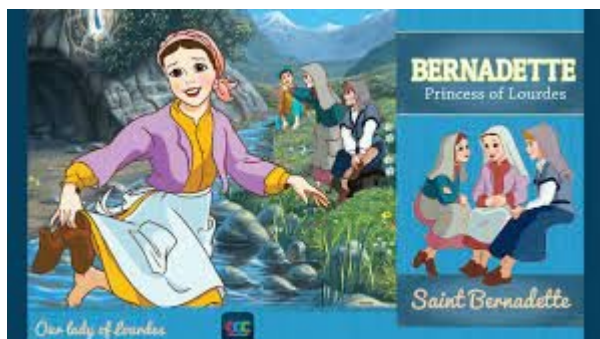
