Marriage: Minimum Six Months notice required. Couples must be practising members of our Parish. Call the Parish office to arrange a meeting with the Pastor.

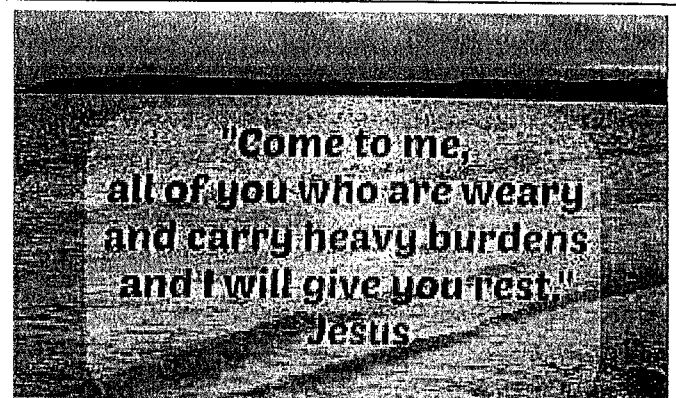

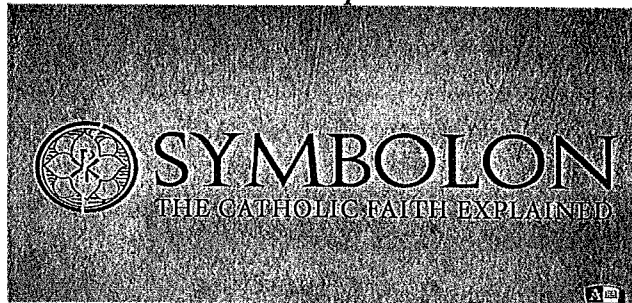

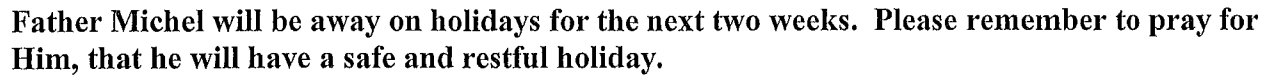
