**Reopening the Church for Sunday Mass**

As of June 21 we are allowed to expand the number of people for Sunday Masses. 50 people will be allowed in the church, and 25 in the Hall. Those wishing to attend Mass will have to call the office to get on the list to attend. Christine will be away on June 30, and July 1st, so please call to reserve a spot on Thursday or Friday, from 9 am till 12 and 1pm till 4pm. **Please do not leave a message** to get on the list, as she needs to let you know if the quota is full or not.

If you do get on the list to attend Mass and for some reason you are unable to come, please let Christine know so she can let someone else attend.

If you can't come, or are not comfortable with going out yet, dispensation from Sunday Masses is still in effect. But you are encouraged to say the Spiritual Communion prayer, available on our website. Also Masses online will still be available as well.
