Afternoon session 1-3, or Evening session 7-9

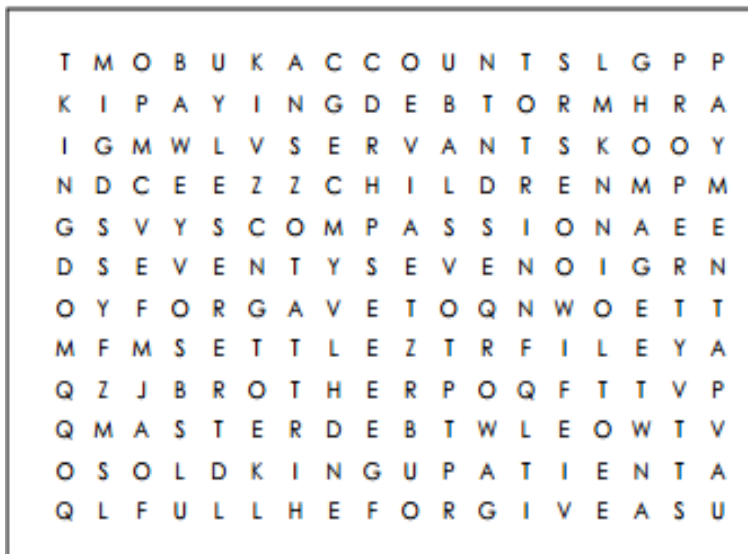
What is a listening session and who should attend?

 - Ongoing training for clergy and lay leaders
 - Formation of the laity in missionary discipleship
 - Initiatives to proclaim the Gospel message and invite all to follow Jesus
- Passing on the Faith to the next generation and to others:**
 - Support the vocation of marriage and family as a domestic church
 - Create welcoming, listening and merciful parishes
 - Youth involvement in parish life and leadership
- Reaching out to others, especially those in need, and those on the peripheries.**
 - Create welcoming, listening, parish communities
 - Assist and advocate for the most vulnerable
 - Discern social and environmental issues

1. What do you appreciate most about St. Viator's parish, especially those things that help you grow in your faith and as a disciple of the Lord?
2. Considering the three Overarching Themes of the Synod (as outlined above), which speaks to you as being the most important at this time? Are there other pastoral challenges for our parish?

An Act of Spiritual Communion

Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

The Principle of Ownership:

The psalmist begins the 24th psalm with, The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it. In the beginning of Genesis, God creates everything and puts Adam in the Garden to work it and to take care of it. It is clear that man was created to work and that work is the stewardship of all of the creation that God has given him. This is the fundamental principle of biblical stewardship. God owns everything, we are simply managers acting on his behalf. Therefore, stewardship expresses our obedience regarding the administration of everything God has placed under our control, which encompasses everything! Stewardship is the commitment of our life and all the possessions to God's service, recognizing that everything is God's.
