An Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

St. Matthew in today's Gospel is trying to remind us that our faith is more than a series of truths or practices, it is a relationship with Jesus. We must have open eyes, ears and hearts to recognize his presence in our midst. We must
