**Marriage:** Minimum **Six months** noticed required. Couples must be practising members of our Parish. Call the Parish Office to arrange a meeting with the priest.

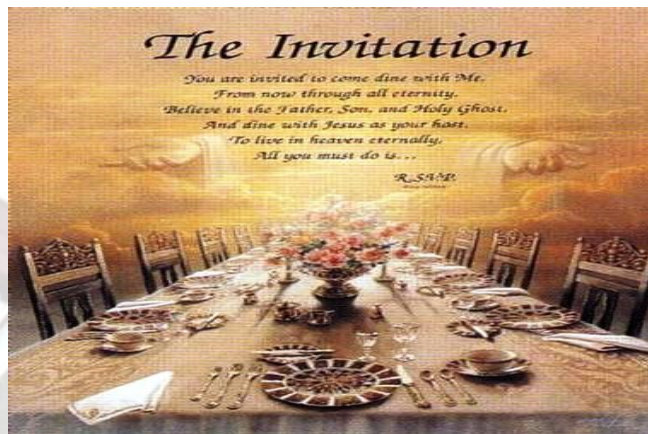
**Ministry of Presence** (The St. Luke Society) If you or someone you know is unable to attend Mass and would like to receive Holy Communion, please contact the parish office.

Never permit me to be separated from You.**



### An Attitude of Gratitude

This is a challenge in today's society. Every day we are bombarded with advertisements that tell us that what we have, how we look, and who we are, simply aren't

good enough. But scripture reminds us differently... *"It is better to be satisfied with what you have than to be always wanting something else."* Ecclesiastes 6.9

We sometimes forget how blessed we are! We take so much for granted. Let us develop our 'Attitude of Gratitude' by first reflecting on what we are grateful for. Make a list of as many things you can think of that you are grateful for, God - Church - Family - Work - Community - Faith etc..... Share your reflections with your family. Developing an 'Attitude of Gratitude' takes practice but it is worth it.

In today's Gospel, note that it is not because the invited guests *could not* come to the wedding feast, but that they *would not* come (see [Luke 13:34](#)). Everyone had an excuse. How tragic, and how indicative of human nature, to be offered the blessings of God and to refuse them because of the draw of mundane things! Jesus has prepared a place for us. We are invited to the Banquet. But, we must respond!
