Can I watch "Formed" on my Smart TV, and How do I do it?

If you have a smart TV, such as Samsung, it may not be possible to log in or play the content from the built in internet browser. It could work, but those browsers are not among our currently supported browsers. Here are the steps you can try:

1. On your TV, open the internet browser and visit the site.
2. Enter your email address, submit, and you will be emailed a link.
3. On a separate device (ie, another computer or mobile device), open your email inbox, open the login email, and click the LOGIN link.
4. Go back to your TV browser, and you should be logged in to watch.

If these steps don't work, your Smart TV will not be compatible. Try connecting your computer or mobile device to your TV using an HDMI cord.
