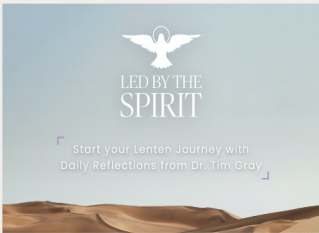
Pick up Your Envelopes

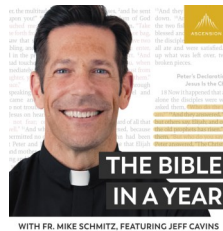
