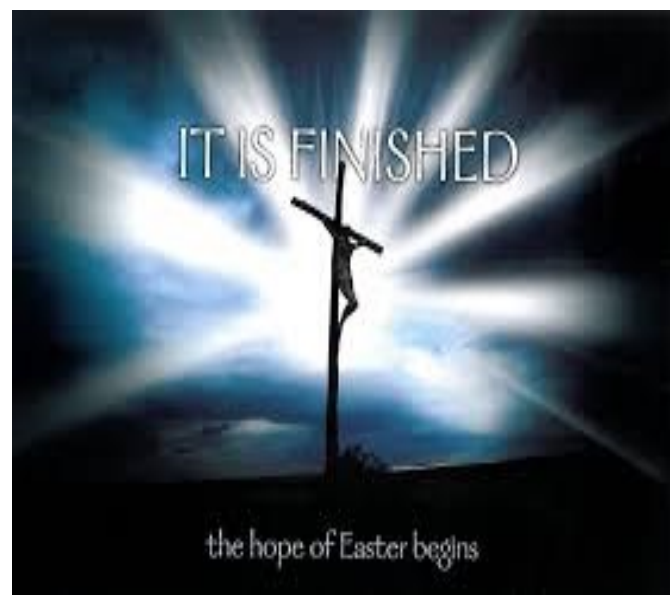

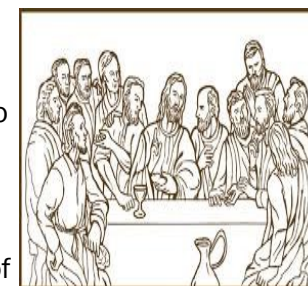

EVENING MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

With the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the Lenten season comes to an end. We now enter the observance of the sacred Three Days known as the Triduum. The ceremonies of Holy Thursday evening, Good Friday afternoon, and Holy Saturday night/ Easter Sunday are really one liturgy commemorating the whole of the Paschal mystery – the passion, burial, and resurrection of Christ.



This evening's Mass not only commemorates the institution of the Holy Eucharist but equally reminds us of our call of service to one another.

THE PASSION OF OUR LORD

The starkness of this afternoon's service helps us to focus on the Passion of Christ and the symbol of the Cross. Because it is the midpoint of the Triduum, the liturgy of Good Friday has neither opening hymn and greeting nor closing hymn and blessing. The ministers of the altar enter and leave in silence. *Please remember that today is also a day of general fasting and abstaining from meat.*

SOLEMN VIGIL OF EASTER

The Easter Vigil is our "night of all nights," the solemnity of solemnities. It is our opportunity to encounter all the basic symbols of our faith and to listen once again to the story of our salvation.

We begin with a service of light that leads into the readings of the Vigil. These passages from the Hebrew Scriptures unfold the story of our ancestors in faith leading up to the coming of Christ. The joyful proclamation of the Easter Gospel – "He is risen!" – is followed by the Renewal of Baptismal Promises. Our service tonight will be lengthier than our usual Sunday Masses. But it is a special night. We invite you to share in the sights, sounds, and smells of the Vigil and together give voice to the Church's "Alleluia."
