More Ministries at St. Viator Parish... Outreach Ministries

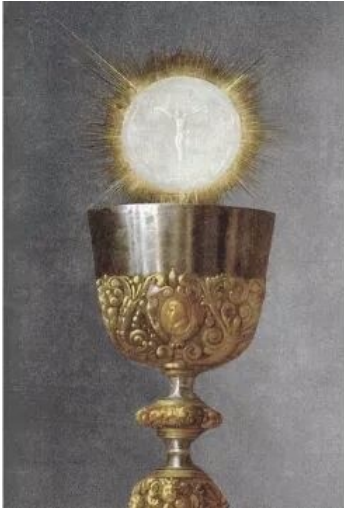
St. Luke Society - St. Luke's ministry provides a service to those, for physical reasons, who are unable to attend Mass. The members bring the Holy Eucharist to their homes, nursing homes and hospitals. Each person is prepared for this mission by a priest. Members are required to sign a pledge of confidentiality. Groups of two take turns visiting on a weekly basis.

Workers of St. Martha—serve God by serving others. This ministry reaches out to others by way of meal preparation, assisting individuals or families in time of crisis or need. Through the generosity of volunteers meals are prepared and delivered for the use of the recipient to help ease the burden of meal preparation. If you know of someone who is going through a difficult time please contact Deloris Lulashnyk, Irene Serwa or the parish office.

St. Viator's Catholic Women's League—is part of a national organization that is rooted in gospel values calling it's members to holiness. The league aids the church in events and fund raising for it's needs. The league also is in the community participating in the things like Meals on Wheel, World Day of Prayer, helping by suppling backpacks full of items for the Women's shelter. The Adopt a Family program is also run by the St. Viator's CWL.. They support the youth of the parish with individual awards as well financial aid for e.g. the Band program. They participate in Remembrance day in our community. Over the past 70 + years the CWL has raised and spent thousands of dollars in our community. The number of members of the CWL has been dwindling. As the members get older and new and younger parishioners have not yet joined we are threatened with extinction. You can help! If you are a women 18 years or older please consider joining this worthy organization. We do not want to see it go the way of the Hospital axillary!

The Knights of Columbus—is a local and international brotherhood of Catholic Men who work to improve the world around them, one community at a time. They serve as support to the parish needs, supplying support to our catechism program yearly. Just recently donating \$50,000.00 to both our parish and the Church of the Resurrection and \$10,000 to the parish in Gilbert Plains. In the community they have sponsored Coats for Kids buying new coats to give out to those in need. They have a variety of wheelchairs that can be loaned to anyone who finds themselves in need of one for a short time. They also raise funds and support an international wheelchair program around the world They volunteer for the Meals on Wheels program and are a presence at the Remembrance Day service. Many other community organizations request and have received donations for their projects. For example The Band program and the Ukrainian dancers, Their membership is getting older and numbers are shrinking. They only ask for **24 hours per year** of their members! These **24** hours can change your life, the life of your church and your community! Please consider joining your local **K of C Celebrating 75 years of service this community this year!**

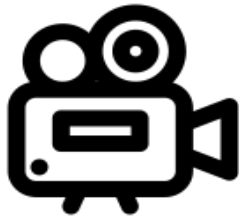

Spiritual Communion**

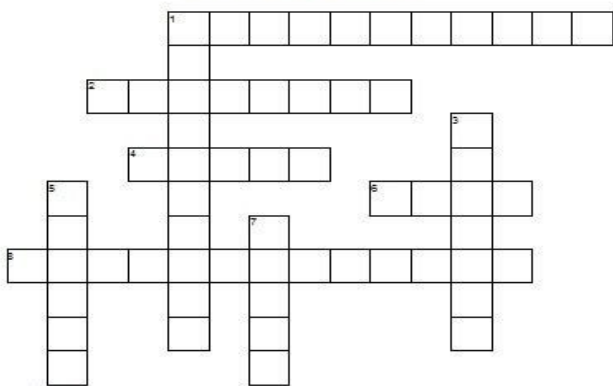
