Act of Love

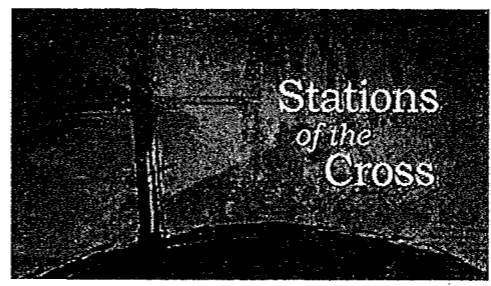
Spend 20 minutes to 30 minutes daily in silent prayer. Prayer is our time with God and where we grow in our relationship with God. Let this week be your time in the desert with God.

Word of Love

In 2003, the entire eastern seaboard of North America was effected by a massive blackout. All sources of energy were cut off – no computers or television. The people effected by the blackout entered the desert of simplicity.

Lent calls us to enter the desert of simplicity. We need to “cut off” those things that keep us from growing in our relationship with God. Jesus spent 40 days in the desert away from the luxuries of life and we too must spend time away from those things that distract us. By “cutting off” distractions, we enter the silence of the desert with Jesus. This is where we begin to grow in our relationship with God and realize what is real.

Reflection
Discuss the ways the world keeps us from entering the silence. What do you do to allow time for silence? What makes it difficult for you to find a silent place?

PRAYER, FASTING & ALMSGIVING

Lent is the Church's primary penitential season in the liturgical year. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and lasts until the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. The season has six Sundays: the final one, known as Passion, or Palm, Sunday, begins Holy Week. The origin of Lenten observances dates back to the fourth century or earlier. The length of the season reflects the forty days Christ spent praying and fasting in the desert, (see Luke 4:1-13) and is a time of preparation for the great feast of Easter. www.catholicfamilyfaith.org/Lenten-season-resources.html
