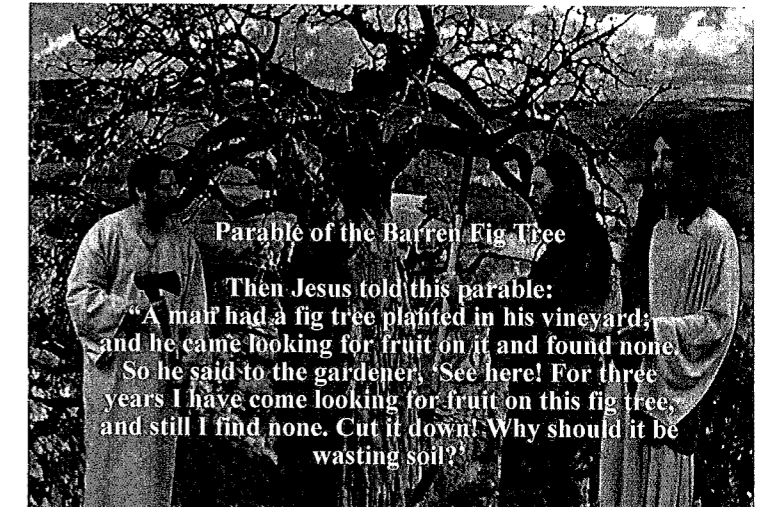
**Marriage:** Minimum Six months noticed required. Couples must be practising members of our Parish. Call the Parish Office to arrange a meeting with the priest.

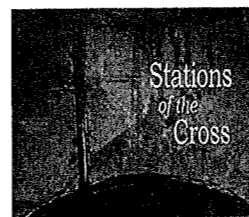
**Word of Love**

The parable of the Barren Fig Tree (Lk 13:6-9) is a rather harsh story, but has an important message. Jesus is teaching us that there are many good things about us and some things we need to get rid of in our life. We must discern what gives our soul life and what is hindering our soul from growing. Basically, Jesus is asking us to do a spring cleaning of our souls. So, we first need to clean out our dirty characteristics and vices we all have inside. Second, we need to pay a little more attention to our souls (i.e. praying and service to others). Third, make the choice to use this spring cleaning for the betterment of our life. By doing this, we have allowed our tree of life to be pruned of the bad parts and strengthened the fruits of our souls.

**Reflection:**

Discuss with friends/family some ways Jesus invites you to renew your spiritual life. Share with your friends/family the gifts they give to you.
