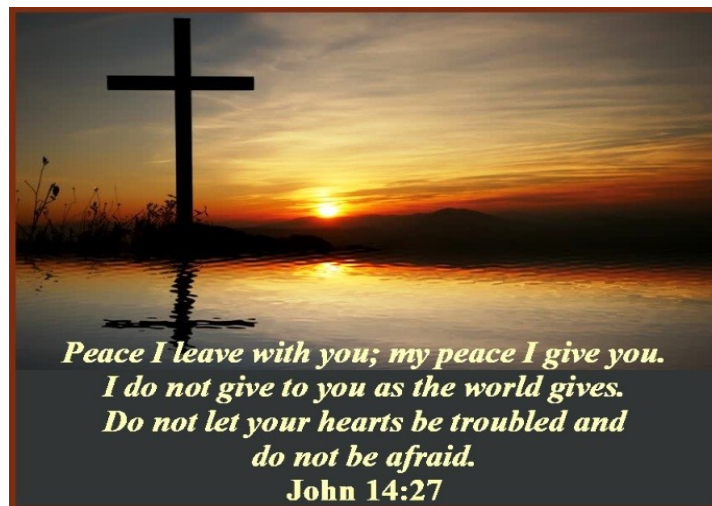

Dear friend,

This is easily the biggest news for pro-lifers in almost half a century.

You've probably heard about what's going on with the Roe v. Wade case at the U.S. Supreme Court, right? The news is everywhere. I couldn't believe my eyes when I saw the headlines Monday night. I mean, you know how Twitter is ... I thought it was a bad internet joke at first, or fake news. The reports appear to be true, though, and here's what we know so far. It looks like the U.S. Supreme Court is close to overturning the 1973 Roe v. Wade abortion decision. An American news organization broke the story, publishing what it says was a leaked copy of an initial draft document by the Justices. The text of that document appears to be a majority opinion of the judges on a recent case before the court, and it says that Roe v. Wade should be overturned. Talk about a bombshell! Just think about it ...

If Roe is officially overturned, we'll see several states become pro-life with total or near-total bans on abortion – and it'll happen pretty much right away! Yes, I'm a bit leery about the motivations behind “leaking” such a sensitive document like this, and there are bigger legal implications to consider here, but I want to say one thing ... I've been praying for this news to come for a long time!

#### END ABORTION IN CANADA

So has the entire pro-life movement, but not everyone was excited ... And you know what? The initial news report was only just the beginning. From the get-go, the radical pro-aborts, even in the Canadian media, were losing their minds. So were our political leaders ... And wouldn't you know it, the most pro-abortion prime minister in our country's history was leading the way.

That's right, Justin Trudeau was on social media, tweeting his support for the favourite myth of the Left, that women have some sort of unquestionable “right” to abortion. Just replace the word “abortion” with “killing an unborn child” and you can see exactly what our political and media elites are after. Think about it for a minute ... They use slogans like: “I will always defend a woman's right to abortion!” In truth, what they're really saying is: “I will always defend a woman's ‘right’ to kill her unborn baby.” Unfortunately, the Roe v. Wade reactions don't end with a few misleading tweets and headlines.

The Bloc Québécois tried passing a motion in the House of Commons the very next day to secure a so-called “legal right to abortion.” They needed unanimous consent for this to pass, but here's the thing ... They didn't have enough support and their motion failed. And do you know what I have to say about that? Good! It's a start, but it's a small win and the larger battle is heating up.

#### MAKE ABORTION ILLEGAL IN CANADA

Campaign Life Coalition was bombarded with media requests Tuesday morning, and we answered as many as we could. It's such a blessing we were able to get the word out about the evils of abortion ...

And how the Canadian pro-life movement is responding to this potentially game-changing news out of the U.S.

The usual army of pro-aborts in politics and the media are scurrying out of the woodwork now, touting the same old lies that Canadian law somehow recognizes a “right” for women to kill their unborn children. But there is no such right. In fact, there's nothing even close to that in the Charter of Rights and Freedoms. My point, though, is this ... We couldn't afford to be on the front lines of this culture war, defending the dignity and sanctity of human life in the public square if wasn't for our supporters.

Believe me – we've been busy enough as it is. The Roe v. Wade news caught us entirely by surprise, like everyone else. But thanks to God's grace, we were able to pivot and respond accordingly. And thanks to the generosity Our Lord inspires in the hearts of our supporters, we were well-positioned to be in the thick of things, delivering an uncompromising pro-life message. Our rights come from God, and the shedding of innocent blood is detestable in His eyes, which is one of the many reasons why abortion is a sin that cries out to Heaven. As the largest pro-life political organization in Canada, we take that truth to heart, knowing full well that our work is far from over.

#### END ABORTION IN CANADA

While the U.S. Supreme Court may be close to overturning the worst human rights decision in its history, we have an uphill battle on this side of the border. Hearts and minds won't change on this over overnight. I also expect we'll see a torrent of pro-abortion rhetoric online and in the media in the days and weeks ahead. That's why we need to keep spreading the word, through as many channels as we can, that every human life is sacred, from the moment of conception until natural death. This is why we won't back down either from holding our pro-abortion lawmakers to account – in the news and in the next election.

So, friend, can you help us?

Right now, abortion exists here in Canada inside a legal vacuum, with zero legal protections for the preborn.

That's why the Roe v. Wade case is so important. While it's ultimately up to Canadians to decide to protect every unborn child targeted for abortion, what happens in the U.S. does eventually affect what happens in Canada. You can already see it in the pro-abortion rhetoric coming out of Parliament and in the mainstream media.

To men like Mr. Trudeau, abortion is somehow “sacred,” which is sickening. The truth is entirely different.

Abortion isn't sacred – it's evil.

That's why we won't stop speaking out against the evils of abortion all across our home and native land.
