Reflections on the Sunday Readings:

In today's Gospel, the Beatitudes reveal the very heart of who Jesus is by turning around everything the world deems important. Blessed are those who are humble and poor, who mourn and are peacemakers, who suffer and are merciful. These blessings stir within us both hope and discomfort, because they challenge us in how we live our lives as faithful Christians. We feel hope because Jesus lived every one of the "blesseds" through his ministry on earth. He speaks to our poverty, sadness and hunger, inviting

these blessings to reside within us. Our path to happiness is through our baptismal calling, where as members of the body of Christ we are anointed to join with Jesus in bringing justice and blessing to the world.

Yet the Beatitudes challenge our human and

worldly aspirations. We discover we may be far from the spirit of these blessings. Christ encourages us to be who we are created to be—a people of love, mercy and compassion. Jesus asks us to live these values, as best we can, for ourselves and others.

Jesus is God-within-us. He promises us his grace and presence in our vulnerability and sinfulness so that, within our human hearts, we can experience the love and promise of God's kingdom.

For those who had their photo taken back in September, you may pick up your copy of the directory after Mass on Saturday and Sunday in the gathering area.




