Reflections on the Sunday Readings:

Imperfections are part of being human. Yet God, as our Father, has set higher standards and wants the best for us. He wishes us to open our eyes to his ultimate plan. He intends us, as sinners who are not immune to toxicity and temptations, to join his kingdom.

God has given us free will. Will we follow him? Are we living only with self-centered goals and desires, or do we make God's Ten

Commandments and Jesus' teachings our guiding light?

Today's readings stress the urgency of aligning ourselves—our behaviour, values and intentions—with God's will. Being faithful to God goes beyond a checklist of rules—and yet we aren't hopeless for break-

ing them, for with a contrite heart our sins can be forgiven. We are encouraged to recognize the importance of righteousness in our hearts, minds and souls. We are asked to love beyond ourselves—making the love of God and others a priority. Our merciful and loving Father isn't expecting perfection. He desires us to at least strive to walk in his ways. While living the Christian way is demanding, let us give thanks to God. He forgives our human imperfections, offering us a life of true joy and peace on this earth and, most importantly, in heaven. Blessed are those who walk in the law of the Lord!

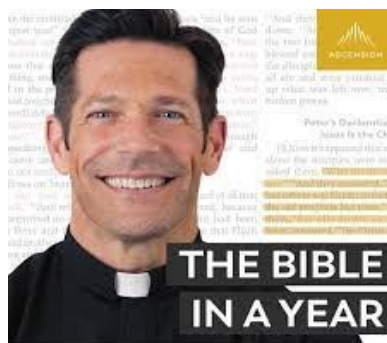

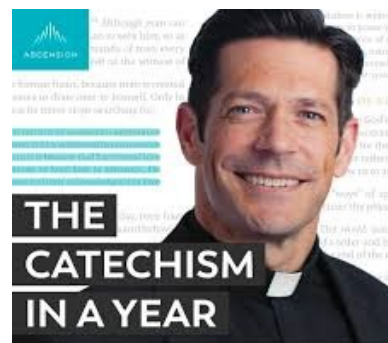

Please be sure to make the change in your calendars, as we need as many hands on deck as possible. Thank you!

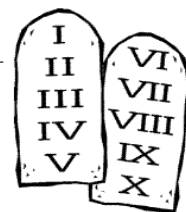
