Life Culture

Dear St. Viator's Roman Catholic Parish, the results from a new Research Co. survey show how much our culture needs the church to be a voice for life.

The study measured Canadians' attitudes towards Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD). The results are sobering, with 73% of Canadians in favour of MAiD under current federal guidelines.

Further:

- 1. 27% of Canadians think MAiD should be allowed for poverty
- 2. 28% for homelessness
- 3. 51% for inability to receive medical treatment
- 4. 43% for mental illness
- 5. 50% for disability



Among 18 to 34 year-olds, the stats are even more concerning:

- 1. 41% think MAiD should be allowed for poverty
- 2. 41% for homelessness
- 3. 57% for inability to receive medical treatment
- 4. 55% for mental illness

60% for disability

MAiD disproportionately targets the vulnerable and marginalized, the very ones Christians are called to defend and care for.
